# Corney & Barrow Sparkling Blanc de Blancs Methode Traditionnelle NV, France

This is just so delicious! Made by traditional method from a blend of Chardonnay, Colombard & Ugni Blanc. The texture is creamy and there is an abundance of fruit freshness with crisp apples and white blossom on the nose and light brioche notes on the palate.

# Château la Tour de l'Eveque Rosé AOC Côtes de Provence 2019

The recent rise and rise of Provence Rosé is no surprise. This is a classic style of quality Provence rosé; dry with vivacious red berry fruit, ripe nectarine and hints of sweet grapefruit. Now in its third generation of the Sumeire family, Régine handles this estate with great expertise. The family have been using organic farming methods from the outset in 1958.

# Shiraz Viognier The Lane 2015, Adelaide Hills, Australia

With more than a nod to the wines of Côte Rôtie, this has been handled with care. Deep, plummy red colour, the nose shows dark fruit with hints of spice. The palate is richly-fruited, smooth and elegant with a characteristic white pepper finish. All the elegance of an old world classic.
